



## ARMA Activity on AN14

ARMA's CEO, Nigel Glen (NG) has been very active in raising awareness of AN14 and its implications for the housing market.

RICS has set up an industry wide Working Group (circa 25 members) and ARMA is seen as central, given that managing agents are on the "front line".
